lesson students may take longer until they become familiar with them especially if the activities are different from current learning activities many of the activities will work best if students work in pairs or small groups some activities can generate noise and therefore be unsettling so teachers will need to be mindful of this when choosing a particular activity they may prefer to do the activity at the end rather than the start of a lesson in this case the purpose of the activity is to consolidate the learning of the lesson the focus of many of the activities is to increase the amount of reading and writing we require students to do also students need to develop their vocabulary in all areas of the curriculum and many of the activities have been developed with this in mind
